



A Pioneer's New Digs

●● In its third location since opening in the Design District in 2001, Glottman continues to engage and provoke design seekers with its uniquely stylized and occasionally irreverent collection. (The current inventory includes a line of high-end sex toys from Love Contemporary.) While Glottman remains a resource for furniture, textiles and home accessories from long-established companies such as Artifort, Zeritalia and Verner Panton, owner and architect Oscar Glottman says that over time his objectives have changed. He's expanding to "present new companies that are producing new ideas that come about through experimenting with materials and technologies." Enter brands such as Moooi, which debuted here with the showroom's opening last September. Now located on the second floor of the Melin Building, the new showroom is drenched in natural light that spills through more than 1,000 dangling acrylic Prismatic lighting diffusers, repurposed as space dividers. In the labyrinthine layout, every nook and cranny of the 6,500-square-foot space reveals a new take on traditional style. Glottman also offers comprehensive interior design services. —Megan Aquilina

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
